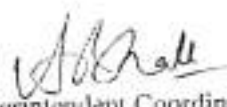

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College Skill Passport: An Integrated Model for Skill Development and Employability in Indian Higher Education

Introduction

Globally, higher education is undergoing substantial changes. Traditionally, the primary indicators of a student's educational success have been university degrees, academic grades, and formal certificates. However, the evolving labour market now places greater emphasis on practical skills such as communication, problem-solving, teamwork, digital literacy, leadership, adaptability, entrepreneurship, and technical abilities. This shift has highlighted the critical distinction between merely holding a qualification and being able to demonstrate relevant competencies. To address this gap, the College Skill Passport has been proposed as an innovative model. It aims to create a comprehensive digital record of a student's academic achievements, skills, internships, projects, micro-credentials, practical experiences, and verified competencies. Rather than replacing the traditional degree, the Skill Passport would serve as a complementary tool, providing tangible evidence of a student's capabilities.

Concept of the College Skill Passport

The College Skill Passport functions as a digital portfolio that meticulously records a student's skill acquisition during their college education. This portfolio includes not only academic accomplishments but also practical and employability skills. For example, a commerce student might document skills such as proficiency in Excel, financial analysis, communication, data analysis, accounting software, teamwork, leadership, and entrepreneurship. Each skill is substantiated by concrete evidence, such as projects, internships, presentations, research, competitions, community activities, or industry assignments. The fundamental principle is "evidence before credential," which dictates that instead of simply awarding a badge for skills like leadership or communication, the system should document the specific activities that demonstrated the skill, the assessments conducted, the evaluators involved, and the level of proficiency achieved.

International Literature and Practices

The extensive body of global literature endorses this approach. A prominent development is the rising use of e-portfolios within higher education institutions. A study conducted in Spain highlights that students perceive professional e-portfolios as instrumental in preparing for the workforce and easing the transition from academia to employment. This research underscores that portfolios can effectively present students' competencies and accomplishments, offering a more holistic view than conventional academic records. This insight is pertinent to the proposed Skill Passport, as it facilitates the systematic documentation of students' educational experiences throughout their academic journey, rather than compiling a professional profile solely upon graduation.

Comparison between International Practices and India

The major difference can be understood in terms of integration. Internationally, e-portfolios, micro-credentials, digital credentials and skills passports are increasingly being developed to make learning outcomes more visible and portable. In Europe, for example, common standards are being developed to improve the quality, transparency and portability of micro-credentials. Australia is exploring a national approach to recording qualifications, certifications and skills. India, meanwhile, has strong policy support for internships, academic credits, multidisciplinary learning and skill development, but the various components are not yet consistently integrated into one verified student competency profile.

This difference creates an important opportunity for Indian higher education. An Indian College Skill Passport could combine **academic credits, internships, projects, micro-credentials, extracurricular activities and competency assessments**. It could therefore provide employers with a richer understanding of graduates than marksheets and degrees alone.

Proposed Structure of the College Skill Passport

The proposed system could contain six major components. The first would be the **Academic Profile**, containing the student's programme, courses, grades, credits, academic achievements and research activities. The second would be the **Skill Profile**, recording competencies such as communication, critical thinking, problem-solving, teamwork, leadership, digital literacy, AI literacy, entrepreneurship and discipline-specific technical skills. The third would be the **Experiential Learning Profile**, containing internships, apprenticeships, industry projects, research projects and community projects.

The fourth component would be **Evidence and Assessment**. Every major skill should be linked to evidence and an assessment. For example, a student could demonstrate communication through a presentation, receive a faculty assessment and achieve a defined competency level. The fifth component would contain **micro-credentials**, allowing students to demonstrate completion of short, assessed learning experiences. The sixth component would be **industry or employer feedback**, through which supervisors could assess students' professional behaviour, teamwork, communication, technical ability and problem-solving during internships or projects.

Student Development Process

The Skill Passport could begin from the first year of college. During the first year, students could undertake career-interest and baseline skill assessments and identify the competencies required for their desired careers. During the second year, they could develop these skills through courses, workshops, projects and micro-credentials. During the third year, they could undertake internships and industry or community projects. In the final year, they could complete a capstone project and competency assessment. At graduation, the student would therefore possess not merely a degree but a **degree supported by a verified portfolio of skills and experiences**.

For example, a B.Com. student interested in financial services might demonstrate Excel proficiency through a financial-analysis project, communication through presentations, data-

analysis skills through an industry project, teamwork through a group assignment, professional competence through an internship. Instead of merely stating that the student completed a B.Com., the Skill Passport would provide evidence of these competencies.

Research Gap

The current body of research has individually addressed topics such as e-portfolios, micro-credentials, internships, experiential learning, and the employability of graduates. Furthermore, there is a noticeable trend in international policy towards valuing digital documentation of skills and qualifications. Despite these developments, there remains a significant gap in research concerning the creation of a comprehensive Skill Passport specifically designed for the Indian higher education system. Such research could focus on identifying the competencies to be evaluated, the methods of assessment, employer recognition, integration with India's existing academic-credit framework, and the potential impact on enhancing students' readiness for their careers.

Proposed Research Objectives

This study aims to examine the disparity in employability and skill development among Indian college students. It will review international models of e-portfolios, micro-credentials, and skills passports, comparing these with practices in Indian higher education. Furthermore, the study will identify competencies valued by employers and develop a College Skill Passport framework tailored to India. The effectiveness of this framework will be evaluated among students, teachers, and employers. Subsequently, a pilot implementation will assess whether students participating in the system demonstrate improvements in career readiness, practical skills, and employability.

Conclusions

The **College Skill Passport** represents a shift from a traditional “**degree plus marks**” model toward a “**degree plus verified competencies**” model. International developments in e-portfolios, European micro-credentials and Australia's emerging National Skills Passport demonstrate that education systems are increasingly interested in making skills visible, assessable and portable. India already has a favourable policy foundation through NEP 2020, internships, academic credit reforms and skill-development initiatives. The major opportunity is therefore to integrate these elements into a single, credible and student-centred system. The proposed model could ultimately help employers answer not only “**What degree does this student have?**” but also “**What can this graduate actually demonstrate?**” This makes the College Skill Passport a promising area for research, institutional innovation and potentially a scalable higher-education reform in India.

सुरक्षित डिजिटल भारत: डिजिटल तकनीक और साइबर सुरक्षा के माध्यम से स्मार्ट एवं सुरक्षित समाज

1. प्रस्तावना

21वीं सदी में डिजिटल तकनीक मानव जीवन का अभिन्न अंग बन चुकी है। आज शिक्षा, स्वास्थ्य, बैंकिंग, व्यापार, कृषि, संचार, परिवहन और सरकारी सेवाओं से लेकर दैनिक जीवन की छोटी-बड़ी आवश्यकताओं तक डिजिटल तकनीक का व्यापक उपयोग हो रहा है। स्मार्टफोन, इंटरनेट, डिजिटल भुगतान, क्लाउड कंप्यूटिंग, आर्टिफिशियल इंटेलिजेंस (AI), इंटरनेट ऑफ थिंग्स (IoT) और डिजिटल पहचान जैसी तकनीकों ने कार्यों को अधिक तेज, सरल और सुविधाजनक बनाया है।

भारत भी तेजी से डिजिटल परिवर्तन की दिशा में आगे बढ़ रहा है। डिजिटल सेवाओं के विस्तार से नागरिकों को घर बैठे अनेक सुविधाएँ प्राप्त हो रही हैं। लेकिन डिजिटल तकनीक के बढ़ते उपयोग के साथ साइबर अपराधों और डिजिटल सुरक्षा से जुड़ी चुनौतियाँ भी बढ़ रही हैं। ऑनलाइन धोखाधड़ी, फिशिंग, OTP फ्रॉड, पहचान की चोरी, डेटा चोरी, फर्जी वेबसाइट, सोशल मीडिया ठगी, साइबर बुलिंग और रैनसमवेयर जैसे खतरे आम नागरिकों, विद्यार्थियों, व्यवसायों तथा संस्थानों के लिए गंभीर चुनौती बन रहे हैं।

इसलिए आज आवश्यकता केवल Digital India की नहीं, बल्कि Secure Digital India की है। हमारा Ideathon इसी विचार पर आधारित है कि डिजिटल तकनीक का विकास तभी सार्थक है जब उसके साथ साइबर सुरक्षा, डेटा गोपनीयता और डिजिटल जागरूकता भी सुनिश्चित हो।

2. समस्या की पहचान

डिजिटल सेवाओं के विस्तार के बावजूद समाज के एक बड़े वर्ग में साइबर सुरक्षा के प्रति पर्याप्त जागरूकता नहीं है। अनेक लोग अनजाने में OTP, PIN, पासवर्ड या व्यक्तिगत जानकारी साझा कर देते हैं। साइबर अपराधी AI और नई तकनीकों का उपयोग करके अधिक विश्वसनीय फर्जी संदेश, कॉल और वेबसाइट तैयार कर रहे हैं।

विशेष रूप से विद्यार्थी, वरिष्ठ नागरिक, ग्रामीण क्षेत्र के लोग और पहली बार डिजिटल सेवाओं का उपयोग करने वाले व्यक्ति साइबर फ्रॉड के प्रति अधिक संवेदनशील हो सकते हैं।

मुख्य समस्याएँ हैं—

1. डिजिटल एवं साइबर सुरक्षा के प्रति जागरूकता का अभाव।
2. ऑनलाइन फ्रॉड की पहचान करने में कठिनाई।
3. फिशिंग और फर्जी वेबसाइटों की बढ़ती समस्या।
4. कमजोर पासवर्ड और असुरक्षित डिजिटल अकाउंट।
5. व्यक्तिगत डेटा और डिजिटल पहचान की सुरक्षा का अभाव।
6. साइबर अपराध की स्थिति में तत्काल सहायता प्राप्त करने में कठिनाई।
7. विद्यार्थियों में साइबर सुरक्षा के व्यावहारिक ज्ञान की कमी।
8. ग्रामीण एवं छोटे शहरों में साइबर सुरक्षा जागरूकता की सीमित पहुँच।

3. प्रस्तावित समाधान – “Cyber Suraksha Saathi”

इस समस्या के समाधान के लिए हमारा innovative concept “Cyber Suraksha Saathi” एक integrated digital platform के रूप में विकसित किया जा सकता है। इसका उद्देश्य नागरिकों को साइबर खतरों से बचाने के लिए Technology + Awareness + Early Detection + Quick Response को एक ही platform पर उपलब्ध कराना होगा।

यह platform मोबाइल application और web portal दोनों के रूप में विकसित किया जा सकता है।

इसका मुख्य उद्देश्य होगा कि कोई व्यक्ति साइबर फ्रॉड का शिकार होने से पहले ही संभावित खतरे की पहचान कर सके और यदि वह किसी साइबर अपराध का शिकार हो जाए तो उसे तुरंत उचित सहायता और मार्गदर्शन मिल सके।

4. AI आधारित Cyber Threat Detection

इस Ideathon का सबसे महत्वपूर्ण innovative component Artificial Intelligence आधारित Cyber Threat Detection System होगा।

AI system किसी SMS, WhatsApp message, email, website link या suspicious communication का analysis करके संभावित खतरे की पहचान कर सकता है। यदि कोई लिंक संदिग्ध दिखाई देता है तो system user को warning दे सकता है।

उदाहरण के लिए यदि किसी व्यक्ति को संदेश प्राप्त होता है—“आपका बैंक अकाउंट बंद होने वाला है, तुरंत इस link पर click करें”—तो system उस message में मौजूद suspicious pattern को पहचानकर user को alert कर सकता है।

इससे cyber fraud होने से पहले ही व्यक्ति को सावधान किया जा सकेगा।

5. Cyber Safety Score

Platform प्रत्येक user के लिए एक “Cyber Safety Score” विकसित कर सकता है। यह score user की digital security practices पर आधारित होगा।

उदाहरण के लिए—

- क्या user ने Two-Factor Authentication लगाया है?
- क्या वह strong password का उपयोग करता है?
- क्या उसके devices updated हैं?
- क्या वह suspicious links से बचता है?
- क्या उसने backup और privacy settings activate की हैं?

इन parameters के आधार पर system user को Cyber Safety Score प्रदान करेगा तथा उसे अपनी digital security बेहतर करने के लिए personalized suggestions देगा।

इससे cybersecurity एक कठिन technical विषय न रहकर सामान्य व्यक्ति के लिए सरल और व्यवहारिक बन सकेगी।

6. विद्यार्थियों के लिए Cyber Security Education

आज के विद्यार्थी डिजिटल technology का सबसे अधिक उपयोग करने वाले वर्गों में हैं। इसलिए schools और colleges में practical cyber safety education को बढ़ावा देना आवश्यक है।

प्रस्तावित platform में “Cyber Safety Learning Zone” बनाया जा सकता है, जिसमें छोटे videos, quizzes, interactive games और real-life examples के माध्यम से cyber security सिखाई जाए।

विद्यार्थियों को विशेष रूप से निम्न विषयों की जानकारी दी जा सकती है—

- Phishing से बचाव
- Safe password practices
- OTP और PIN की सुरक्षा
- Social media privacy
- Online gaming safety
- Cyber bullying
- Fake job और scholarship scams
- Digital payment fraud
- AI-generated fake content की पहचान

इससे विद्यार्थियों को केवल theoretical knowledge नहीं बल्कि वास्तविक जीवन में उपयोगी cybersecurity skills प्राप्त होंगी।

7. ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों के लिए Digital Cyber Awareness

Cybersecurity का लाभ केवल urban population तक सीमित नहीं रहना चाहिए। ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों में भी digital payments और online government services का उपयोग तेजी से बढ़ रहा है।

इसलिए "Cyber Awareness on Wheels" जैसे mobile awareness programmes चलाए जा सकते हैं। पंचायतों, सरकारी कॉलेजों, स्कूलों और ग्रामीण सेवा केंद्रों में स्थानीय भाषा में cyber awareness sessions आयोजित किए जा सकते हैं।

सरल भाषा में लोगों को समझाया जा सकता है कि—

"OTP किसी को न बताएं, unknown link पर click न करें और किसी भी अनजान व्यक्ति के कहने पर screen sharing न करें।"

8. Digital Payment Security

Application users को suspicious payment requests, fake QR codes, fraudulent links और अन्य संभावित scams के बारे में alert कर सकती है।

Payment करने से पहले system user को एक simple "Pause – Check – Pay" mechanism के माध्यम से सावधान कर सकता है।

Pause: क्या payment request वास्तव में आवश्यक है?

Check: क्या receiver और payment details सही हैं?

Pay: पूरी तरह सुनिश्चित होने के बाद ही payment करें।

यह छोटी-सी प्रक्रिया अनेक digital frauds को रोकने में सहायक हो सकती है।

9. Cyber Incident Response

यदि कोई व्यक्ति cyber fraud का शिकार हो जाता है तो सबसे महत्वपूर्ण चीज है—समय पर सही कदम उठाना।

Cyber Suraksha Saathi में एक Quick Response Guide उपलब्ध हो सकती है, जो user को स्थिति के अनुसार step-by-step guidance दे।

उदाहरण के लिए—

"मेरे account से unauthorized transaction हुआ है"

"मेरी social media ID hack हो गई है"

"मुझे suspicious link प्राप्त हुआ है"

"मैं online scam का शिकार हो गया हूँ"

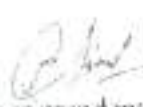

As you are aware, the Government of Haryana, in collaboration with the National Skill Development Corporation, is launching the *Haryana Yuva Udyami Yatra* across all 23 districts of Haryana from **21st August 2026 to 11th December 2026**.

2. The Haryana Yuva Udyami Yatra — a statewide initiative focusing on **Youth Skill, Employment, Startup & Entrepreneurship**—is being planned by the Industries & Commerce Department, Haryana.
